

Queensland Resources Council / University of Queensland Pre-service Teacher Awards (2010)

Recognising exemplary units of work related to furthering students' exploration of minerals and energy education

ENTRY INFORMATION

The Awards are open to University of Queensland (UQ) students who are enrolled in a Bachelor or Graduate Diploma of Education degree.

The Queensland Resources Council (QRC) is a non-profit peak industry association for the minerals and energy sector in Queensland. One of the roles of the QRC is to support the development of a quality workforce for the resources sector in Queensland.

The ability to attract and retain increasing numbers of skilled employees is a key issue for QRC's member companies. QRC recognises that a long-term sustainable solution for ensuring a future workforce for the resources sector includes supporting and recognising the need for more pre-service teachers specialising in areas such as mathematics, technology and science, to make these disciplines more readily accessible to students and schools.

ABOUT THE AWARDS

The Awards recognise excellence in minerals and energy education. These awards are sponsored and managed by the QRC and supported by UQ.

The Awards are offered to recognise Pre-service teachers undertaking maths, science and SOSE specialisations, who will provide the future education to school students in subject areas relevant to the resources sector. The prize-winning developer/s will be acknowledged on the Oresome Resources website.

In 2010, the QRC will present up to three cash prizes to pre-service teachers at UQ. The Awards recognise the design of an original and exemplary sequence of teaching ideas related to furthering students' exploration of minerals and energy issues. UQ Pre-service teachers can submit entries in one or more of the following areas:

- Science – Chemistry, Physics, Junior Science
- Mathematics
- SOSE – Senior or Junior Geography and SOSE

The sequence of teaching ideas can focus on either the senior years (10 – 12) or be linked to the essential learnings for Years 7 or 9 of the relevant Queensland Syllabus. The entry must include a unit outline with syllabus links, at least one hands-on activity / experiment and a literacy or numeracy task. Incorporation of ICT-based activities is encouraged. All resources should be included in the entry.

All work must qualify for assessment in an education program at UQ in 2010. UQ academic staff from the Education Faculty will short-list entries and refer them to the QRC Awards Panel for consideration. The QRC Award Panel consists of teaching and industry experts. As a condition of entry, the QRC reserves the right to edit and publish the winning entries on oresomerresources.com to encourage other teachers to use these teaching ideas and resources.

THE PRIZES

Gold Award \$1,000

Silver Award \$600

Bronze Award \$400

The awardees will also be presented with a certificate and receive an invitation to attend a presentation ceremony, in early 2011, with key QRC and UQ dignitaries present.

PLEASE NOTE

- 'Pre-service teacher' means a student who is enrolled in a Bachelor or Graduate Diploma pre-service teaching degree.
- 'Awards' mean the Queensland Resources Council/ University of Queensland Pre-service Teacher Awards
- 'Program' means an approved tertiary pre-service teaching degree conducted by UQ
- 'Resources sector' means the minerals and energy industry in Queensland.

HOW TO ENTER

Applicants are required to submit:

- Cover Sheet page, signed
- Terms and Conditions page, signed
- The sequence of teaching ideas related to furthering students' exploration of minerals and energy issues, and all supporting teaching resources.
- For group entries, please nominate **one** person to whom an award-winning cheque will be made out.
- The applications must be submitted to Annette Hilton, The University of Queensland, Building 24, St Lucia Campus by the closing date.
- The entries will be shortlisted by UQ Education Faculty staff and then provided to the QRC Awards Panel for final consideration.
- Successful applicants will be advised in December 2010.
